About us

The University of Plymouth is co-delivering a pan-European project to see if social entrepreneurship and volunteering could help unemployed young people get on the career ladder. We aim to foster knowledge, skills, competences and attitudes by using the following methods:

What the research is about

Right to withdraw

You have the right to stop taking part in the research at any time, including during the data collection or afterwards up to the point at which the data is analysed. You also have a right not to answer specific questions or to ask for audio and video-recording to stop.
