- Pilot ran in 2015/16 and moved to be a supported system in 2016/17
 - Available in every teaching space across 3 campuses
 - Run as a opt-in system and academic-led system
 - Seen year on year growth in systems lifetime
 - Since the 2016/17 over 3000 days worth of content has been viewed by students

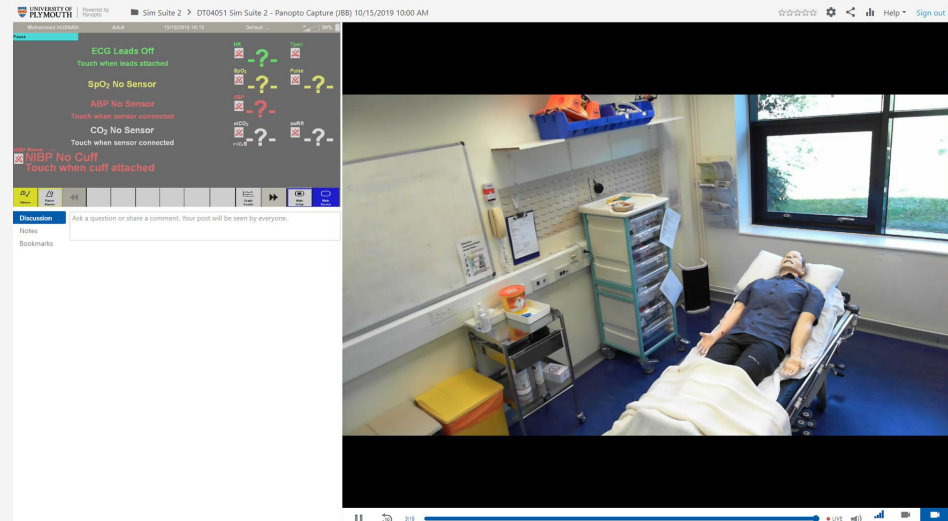
